Behaviour Policy Updated May 18.5.20

Appendix

In response to the reopening of school, changes have been made to our rights respecting behaviour policy in order to ensure that every child and member of staff has the right to be safe (Article 19)

Outside

It is vital that pupils accept and follow adult instruction at the start and end of the day. Pupils will be instructed to line up and walk across the playground keeping a safe distance from others.

At break and lunchtime there will be no football, pupils will be instructed to keep a safe distance from others and stay within their class areas, this does not stop pupils talking to one another.

Inside

Pupils must follow instructions and wash hands carefully. Be patient and wait for their turn. When walking around school pupils must use the red and yellow lines to keep their distance and keep to the left at all times. Pupils must ask to use the toilets and wash hands carefully afterwards.

Pupils have their own set of resources on their own desk. Pupils must not share these resources with any body else. They must not share drinking bottles or lunches.

Pupils must tell an adult if they feel unwell and follow the catch it, bin it, kill it posters in the classrooms if they cough or sneeze

At home

Pupils working from home are expected to follow our acceptable use and e safety policy.

Any child posting inappropriate messages will have their parents contacted to make them aware and enable them to monitor their child at home.

Note

Pupils whose behaviour does not follow these expectations will be sanctioned using our behaviour zones as per our policy.

Pupils who refuse to follow instruction, deliberately cough or sneeze at, or approach another child or adult, will be sent to pastoral support and will work in isolation and their parents will be phoned to discuss next steps.
