The infographic provides a comprehensive overview of WhatsApp's features and associated risks for parents and educators. It is divided into several sections:

- WHAT ARE THE RISKS?**: Discusses the lack of end-to-end encryption for group chats and the potential for data interception.
- EVOLVING SCAMS**: Warns about phishing attempts and malicious links.
- CONTACT FROM STRANGERS**: Highlights the risk of receiving messages from unknown contacts.
- FAKE NEWS**: Notes that WhatsApp has been used to spread misinformation.
- CHAT LOCK AND SECRET CODES**: Explains how to use these features for privacy.
- VIEW ONCE CONTENT**: Warns that content disappears after one view.
- VISIBLE LOCATION**: Warns that location sharing can be turned on by accident.
- ADJUST THE SETTINGS**: Provides instructions on how to control privacy settings.
- CHAT ABOUT PRIVACY**: Encourages open communication with children about online safety.
- DISCUSS GROUP CHATS**: Advises on how to manage group chat settings and member lists.
- THINK BEFORE SHARING**: Emphasizes the importance of not sharing sensitive information.
